

Supply List for Preschool 2017-2018

- *Standard-size backpack with two shoulder straps, no wheels or drawstrings **labeled with child's name**
- *Change of clothes to be kept in the classroom all year in a Zip-Loc bag **labeled with child's name** (ex. T-shirt, sweatpants, socks, underwear)
- *Kinder-Mat **labeled with child's name** (tri-fold; make sure it is blue and red)
- *Standard size beach towel **labeled with child's name**
- *Snack fee donation = \$5 a month or \$45 for the year
- *Craft/Supply fee donation = \$10 for the year
- *3 *HOT* glue sticks (.28in diameter)
- *2 large containers of Lysol/Clorox wipes
- *1 sandwich size storage bag (ex. Zip-loc)
- *1 snack size storage bag (ex. Zip-loc)
- *1 bottle of hand soap (ex. Soft Soap)
- *1 container of 5oz. Dixie cups (do not get the 3oz. please)
- *1 box of tissues

Dear Parents,

Your child will need the following items for kindergarten next year.

1. Three boxes of regular size crayons. (Crayola 8 pack)
2. A regular size backpack no wheels or drawstrings please.
3. Two boxes of Dixie cups (5oz.) (Great Valu has these or you can get a 5oz. cup at Costco) Please DO NOT get the 3 oz. cups
4. Two white t-shirts. Please get these big enough to wear through the spring. Size 10-12 works well for most children, so that long sleeve shirts can be worn underneath on field trips.
5. One kinder mat (tri-fold kind) no roll ups. (Miss Lambert will pass mats over to me if your child has one.)
6. A towel for rest time (beach towel or bath towel) no blankets please.
7. Your child will have a monthly snack fee of \$5.00 while in kindergarten. You can pay monthly or pay it all at once which will be \$45.00.
10. Extra set of clothes preferably sweat pants and a T-shirt works well with underpants and socks. (Please put these in a gallon size Ziploc bag with their name on the bag)
11. One baby shoe or recently outgrown shoe for a special project.
12. Headphones for computer lab. The ear buds do not work that well.
13. Roll of paper towels
14. 6 glue sticks
15. Box of tissues
16. \$10 art fee for the year.
17. 1 package of the square dinner napkins.
18. 3 black dry erase markers.
19. 1 bottle of glue (4oz and Elmer's glue please)
20. Pencil Box regular size

Optional: Bag of cotton balls - Wet wipes - Roll of paper towels
