6th grade suggested supply list

- \sim You will need 1 single composition notebook, 3 spiral notebooks, and 1 pack of loose leaf notebook paper for the classroom.
- ~ We ask every student to bring in 1 box of tissues. We can go through several boxes when allergy and cold season hits. (Do they ever go away anymore?)
- \sim Gym shoes are needed for PE, and sneakers for outdoor recess if you wear flip flops. These can be kept in the cubbies.
- ~ You will need pencils, as well as erasers. We ask that you bring #2 lead pencils, and <u>NO Mechanical Pencils</u>. We require all assignments to be completed in pencil.
- \sim You can bring your own calculator and other math utensils, but we supply these.
- \sim You will want to have a pencil box with art supplies like crayons, markers, glue and scissors. While we supply all of these materials, many students prefer to have their own.
- \sim You will want to have another smaller pencil box or pouch to keep pencils in when you switch classes for Science and Social Studies.
- ~ Pencil sharpeners are <u>not allowed</u> because there is not room for them in our desks and they tend to make a mess of our room.
- ~A flash drive (jump drive) may be useful in completing projects at school. This does not need to be an expensive purchase, a cheap flash drive will do. We do supply these too!
 - ~ You may want your own computer ear buds or headsets.
