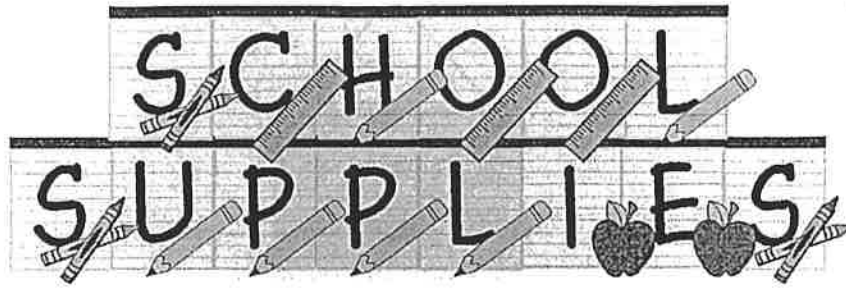

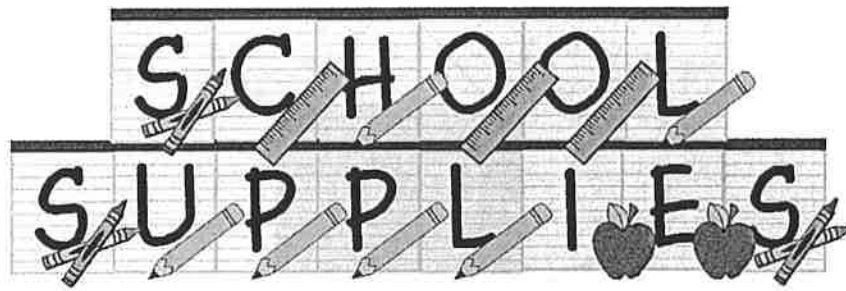

Please encourage your child to read over the summer. Reading just 10 minutes a day can really help. Have them read to a friend, a brother or sister, or to anyone that will listen.

Learning the multiplication facts is one of the most important math skills taught at the third grade level. Over the summer, if your child studies them for just 15 minutes a day, it can really make math easier for them next year. You can purchase flashcards that will help or make your own.

When you start shopping for school supplies, here is a list of suggested items needed for third grade. The State department says that we can no longer require our students to buy school supplies, but we may suggest them.

- 1 .Three spiral notebooks
2. Loose-leaf notebook paper
3. Box of crayons /colored pencils/colored markers
4. Small bottle of Elmer's glue and a 2pk glue stick
5. Sharpened pencils (solid wood/no decorative wraps) with erasers
6. One box of tissues
7. Bookbag (none with wheels due to lack of space)
8. One dry erase markers
9. Pencil box (large enough to hold glue, crayons, and pencils)
10. Gym shoes for PE (May be kept in cubby for PE classes)
- 11 .Container of cleaning wipes(Clorox or Lysol) Bleachfree!

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Fifth Grade (5A). I am looking forward to working with you and your child.

Please encourage your child to read at least twenty minutes each day during the summer. They can read to you or a sibling. This will greatly benefit them as they come into fifth grade. We will be reading A LOT!

All students NEED to know their multiplication tables by fifth grade. Your child will struggle in math if they don't know these by next school year. Please practice the tables with your child each day. They should know their facts up to twelve. You can purchase a set of flashcards and practice for about 10 minutes per day. You can also use the internet and find a site to practice these. If you help your child learn these, this will greatly increase their success in math class. Thank you for your help.

When you start shopping for school supplies here is a suggested list for fifth grade. The State Department states that we can no longer require our students to buy school supplies but we may suggest them.

- Two big boxes of tissues (We will need these for the entire school Year)
- One container of Lysol cleaning wipes
- One package of ****black**** dry erase markers (1 - 3)
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Sharpened Pencils with erasers, Pencil Box large enough for crayons, pencils, etc. ****No Mechanical Pencils Please****
- Three - 75 page spiral notebooks
- One Composition book for Science
- A two pocket folder for Science, Social Studies, and Reading (3) all together
- One 1" three ring Binder for Math
- Book bag
- Tennis shoes must be worn during recess and PE class (Usually one set stays at the school for PE.)
